subtracted from your total, this allows Applebee's to mark your check for 15% back to the WIN committee

5) checkout & pick-up your meal at your designated time.

ISSUES:

VOTER RIGHTS: The Political Action Committee is still concerned about whether people incarcerated at the Montgomery County Jail are being properly informed about their right to vote and given access to voting materials. We wrote a letter to Ken Lawrence, Montgomery County Commissioner and chair of the county Board of Elections, and recently received a lengthy reply outlining what the prison's policies are relative to voting. We'll evaluate further.
